
### Do they work?

# The purpose of the tender



- To end up with a complete solution, able to:
  - Increase the quality of life and self-reliance for citizens in their own homes, who receive help for security and overview of dosage, physical control of the pills, cognitive control of pills and competence for correct picking up and taking medicine
  - Increase the health care quality, fewer unintended incidents
  - Improves the employees' physical working environment and increases work satisfaction
  - Reduces costs related to dosage, reminder and medicine delivery.



### Who?



- Citizens living in their own homes, receiving aid from homecare or nursing, concerning medication.
  - Dispensation (effort in which staff count or prepare prescribed medication for administration)
  - Administration (where staff provide medicine and helps citizens take the medicine and observe the citizens)

### Economy



- 158 mio. kr. per year in the 9 municipalities (26 million USD)
- 357.500 hours per year (73% administration / 26% dosage)
- 6.217 citizens receiving aid for medication
- 1.731 citizens receiving aid, only for medication

 Additional benefits from better medication and hence an improved health: Fewer hospitalizations, doctor visits, general aid...? Employee time, including driving (158 million per year)






### TIM (Total solution for Intelligent Medication aid)

- includes the entire journey of the medicine





Software from CareConsult connecting the partners and making it possible to make day to day changes in the medication, based on the citizens' "Fælles medicinkort"

## TIM (Medimi Smart)



- Automatic dosage:
  - Integrated to the e-health system (always the correct and updated dosage)
  - Able to dose Scheduled medicine, to pre-dose, to dose need-medicine and to remind of other types of medication
  - Self controlling the dosage
- Reminding the citizens to take the medicine (including light, sound and SMS)
  - Notifying the control center, if the citizen does not take the medicine
- Prodiving overview of the medication
- Providing compliance og documentation
- All medicine placed inside the MS

# Learnings so far



- From testing:
  - The citizens have clear attitudes
  - Our citizens receiving aid, are both physically and cognitively weakened
  - One size doesn't fit all
  - There is a need for further development, in certain details.
- A few selected results of our premeasurements:
  - 35% of visits are medication only
  - 44 % of the time used for an administration visit is driving
  - In average, the employee is interrupted 2,32 times per dispensing visit.
  - 89% of the employees feel, that dispensing medicine helps them understand the citizens' situation
  - Almost all citizens feels safe about our employees aid, and agree that the employees learn about the citizens, when visiting.
