Furthermore, approach and specific berthing info will be given to Masters in Bergen before commencing journey towards Aarhus.

2.2 Tides

Under normal weather conditions tide and currents are minimal in the Port of Aarhus. Tidal fluctuations between +- 30 cm can be expected and currents in the area are negligible.

2.3 Frequences

VHF channel 12 is the principal port operations frequency and should be used for all arrival communications, pilotage requests and emergency situations.

2.4 Call Signs

The call sign is "Aarhus Port"



2.5 Arrival procedure

- Monitor VHF Ch. 12 and Ch. 16
- Call Port of Aarhus (VHF Ch. 12 Port of Aarhus) 2-hours prior arrival approach buoy Aarhus. State requirements (Pilot, Tugs, Linesmen). Updated berthing info will be advised from port.
- Call Port of Aarhus again (VHF Ch. 12 Port of Aarhus)
- 1-hour prior arrival to confirm arrangements and ETA.
- All inbound vessels for Port of Aarhus must broadcast intentions (VHF Ch. 12) on passing approach buoy.
- All outbound vessels must broadcast departure (VHF Ch. 12) on departure from berth.
- Upon passing approach buoy attention must be paid to arriving/departing High-speed ferries (also monitoring VHF Ch. 12). Port of Aarhus will assist if necessary.

2.6 Practical berthing info

Assistance:

- Pilots, tugs and linesmen are monitoring VHF Ch. 12
- There are no legal requirements for pilots or tugs in Port of Aarhus
- If using tug assistance, pilot is required
- Pilots and tugs assistance must be ordered 2-hours prior arrival/departure.
- Linesmen must be ordered 1-hour prior arrival/departure.
- Pilot, tugs and linesmen are free of charge for all ships (covering 1 arrival and 1 departure). However, class A ships have first priority, if pilots and tugs are needed by more ships.
- Fendering in berthing areas are car tires. Yokohama fenders are not available from the port.
- Vessels are expected to provide fendering and gangway arrangements themselves.
- Some vessels will be doubleberthed.

Port of Aarhus expect all vessels to comply with relevant legislation regarding mooring and gangway arrangements. 2.7 Customs & Immigration

Change of trainees or crew in Aarhus

If you have crew or trainees (passengers) that disembark or embark in Aarhus, you need to fill out the Excel form "01 Transfer Aarhus TSR19".

Deadline for informing the Danish police is no later than 24 hours prior to arriving in Aarhus, that is July 31, 2019 at 12:00.

Visa rules

If the vessel carries crew or trainees on board from countries that have a visa requirement to enter Denmark (Schengen visa), the following rules apply:

Crew:

If the crew member is listed in the vessel's crew list and reported to SafeSeaNet, the crew member can use his/her Seamen's book to enter Aarhus.

If the vessels has a crew member, holding a valid Schengen visa and a Seamen's book, who needs to transfer from the Port of Aarhus back to his/her home country, please contact cke@aarhus.dk for further assistance. The crew member needs to receive an official transfer approval from the police.

Trainees (passengers):

Trainees that hold a valid visa to Schengen also needs to bring along his/her national passport or residence permit.

If the vessel has trainees (passengers) onboard, that have a valid visa to Schengen, the captains needs to inform the police by send a list with names and visa information to ojyl-transfer@politi.dk AND ojyl-graense-kontrollen@politi.dk.

Border control

Border control will be carried out in Aarhus by the Danish police on selected vessels upon arrival.

SafeSeaNet:

Under EU regulation 2017/458 all vessels must be registered with and use Safeseanet when entering Denmark. To gain access to the Danish Safeseanet, please see below instruction:

- 1. If you do not have a password already to SafeSeaNet send your request in to Safeseanet@safeseanet.dk If you do have a password, jump to step 3.
- 2. A password and user name will be sent to you by e-mail.
- 3. Log in to Safeseanet and upload the required data no later than 23 July 2019 prior to departure from Bergen.
- 4. Latest 1 hour after arriving in port of Aarhus, log in to Safeseanet again, and insert actual time of arrival (ATA). The report will then change status to completed.
- 5. Latest 24 hour before departure, log in to Safeseanet and create a departure report
- 6. Latest 1 hour after departure from port of Aarhus, login to Safeseanet again, and insert actual time of departure (ATD). Report will then change status to completed.


State and Navy vessels are required to use Safeseanet. State and Naval vessel are also required to notify Eastern Jutlands Police of those who are embarking or disembarking in Aarhus, via Email ojyl@politi.dk

State and Navy vessels are required, no later than 4 weeks prior to the 31th July 2019, to have applied for Diploclearance through their own respective embassies on Danish soil.

3. Berthing

3.1 Special Berthing Instructions

- Mooring:

Mooring position will be ordered by the port over the VHF channel 12

- Line handlers:

If necessary there will be line handler on the quayside. Masters are reminded that they have a duty to ensure that access to their vessel is safe. Vessels will in general provide their own gangways and fenders.

Experienced marine and berthing staff will be located at the Harbor Office throughout the period of your stay. Further information can be obtained through your LO's.

- Fenders and Gangways:

All vessels are expected to provide their own fenders and means of access to the shore.

Please be aware, that the harbor do NOT have Yokohama-fender, they only have rubber tyres.

3.2 Formalities Dress ship:

No special requirement other than normal naval etiquette. However, the ships are invited to "Dress Overall" during the stay in Aarhus, weather permitting.







6.3 Parade of Sail


The parade of sail on Sunday takes place on August 4th.

The order of departure for the vessels will be decided by the Port of Aarhus as the tug boats and the "push me"-boats needs to be in place. The first vessels are expected to leave the port at 10:00. First vessel to cross the parade mark at 12.00, see pink dot on map below.

In order to give the public a fantastic view of the vessels when they leave the City of Aarhus, we encourage all Captains to follow, if possible, the indicated route shown on the map below

7.1 Crew Parade

Crew Parade will take place Friday August 2nd 14.00-15.30.

- 13.45 The crews meet their LO's in front of the vessel and will be guided to the line up area in Sydhavnsgade to gather with the other crews
- 14.00 Lineup at Sydhavnsgade
- 14.30 The parade begins and goes through the city centre. It ends in front of the main stage at 15.30 for the prize giving ceremony
 The route distance is 1,9 km. and goes through the central part of the city and the main shopping street (see map)

All crew are expected, as far as possible, to attend the parade.

All are encouraged to entertain, sing or dance for the many spectators along the route.

Please follow these instructions for the line up!:

- The street called Sydhavnsgade is divided into zones
- Each zone will be marked with a volunteer holding a sign with the zone number

The Host Port of Aarhus welcomes all the crew members to a night of fun with delicious food, DJ and dancing


Admission is strictly restricted to crew members wearing the Tall Ships Races wristbands AND the Crew Party wristband provided by the STI



9. Liaison System

9.1 Liaison System

Aarhus has assigned dedicated liaison officers (LO's) to each vessel in The Tall Ships Races. They will all be dressed in orange colored t-shirts and wear credentials. Your vessel will be met by a team of LO's upon arrival in the Port of Aarhus. The LO's will then be at your service every day and will report on board after the early Liaison Officer briefings. First visit is expected around 9am

Through the LO's, we will provide you with essential information, much of which is contained within this manual, and will keep you up-to-date with any revised or new material throughout your stay in Aarhus. Your LO's will be pleased to assist you with any queries you may have and to help you with various arrangements that will be required during your stay - details of which appear in this manual.

The LO's aim is to enable you and your crew to enjoy your visit in Aarhus. They will advice you of full details of the activities organized for captains and crews.

In order to provide the maximum assistance, we anticipate that your LO's will spend as much time as possible with your vessel and crew, and you are cordially requested to afford your LO's suitable facilities.

All LOs are equipped with a mobile telephone to ensure the best contact between your vessel and the designated team of LO's. Name, contact details of your team of LO's and LO team phone number will be provided by your designated LO team upon arrival.

The LO system can also be contacted by addressing the staff in the LO and Volunteer Centre.

10. Ship Services

10.1 Fuel

There will be opportunity to refuel oil i Port of Aarhus

Fuel have to be ordered prior to arrival in Aarhus. Deadline for ordering is 29th of July.

Fuel must be ordered using the enclosed form. Only vessels with guild tax / VAT munbers have the opportunity to refrain from paying tax.

Fuel will be provided by tanker vehicle directly at the ships.

Fueling takes place Thursday 1st and Friday 2nd August in the periode 6 to 10 am.

10.2 Water

Fresh water will be available at the berths. Ships are supposed to use their own horses as far as possible, and the crews to fill their own water tanks. Filling of tanks should be done at night or in the morning to avoid hoses on the quay in rush hour.

10.3 Electricity

Ships without own generator can ask for electricity through the LO's. Whilst every effort will be made to supply those Class B, C, and D vessels requiring an electrical supply, there is no guarantee, and ships cannot expect to receive electricity constantly during the event.

10.4 Waste

Ships should use their own garbage sacks for garbage. Waste sacks are to be brought to waste containers on the quay between 01.00 am and 07.00 am by the crew members.

Vessels that do not deliver their waste in the quay containers before 07.00 am will need to bring the waste to centrally located waste containers.

In Aarhus, waste will be collected in four categories:

- Glas/metal
- Paper/cardboard
- Food waste
- Trash (residual waste)

10.5 Sewage and Bilge Water

Sewage and bilge water emptying should be ordered prior to arrival.

Deadline for ordering is 29th of July.

Please, help us to take care of the clean water in the Port of Aarhus.

Sewage and bilge water is to be collected by a special vehicle and should not be pumped overboard.

There is one free emptying per vessel.

10.6 Gas

Gas have to be ordered prior to arrival in Aarhus. Gas cylinders can be ordered by sending to the mail below.

Deadline for ordering is 29th of July

Propane or liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) is subject to Danish legislation, that means gas can be exchanged only in Danish standard cylinder.

12. Sustainability

12.1 Tall Ships Races Aarhus Sustainability

The City of Aarhus has developed a new and greener sustainability-event-strategy. This means, that we will be working to improve sustainability on following areas:

Transport

We are making it easier for guests to get to Tall Ships Races by bicycle or public transport. We do this by improving bicycle parking-facilities and communicating the sustainable alternatives to getting here in car. During the event we will offer the audience sails in our solar energy-driven ferry "Solfærgen". Intern transportation will primarily be by bicycles or in electronic cars.

Waste

We offer waste sorting for our guests, just as we sort waste backstage. We cooperate with the local recycling center ReUse about loan of furniture and other interior to minimize consuming and promote recycling. We will be making sweeps in the sea in cooperation with local sailing and surf clubs.

Food

We prioritize local production, organics, food waste avoidance and FSC certified packaging in the selection of food stalls on the event site. Furthermore, we will prioritize a broad selection of food stalls, and make sure that we also offer vegetarian and vegan food.

Energy

We use as energy effective solutions as possible. The total energy use of the event will be coming from windmills and other renewable energy sources. If generators are to be used, we will make sure that they use biodiesel. Finally, our electric cars will be charged at night, where there is a lot of excess power.

Volunteers

In cooperation with the Aarhus volunteers (Rethinkers) we are educating a special group of volunteers in sustainability. The volunteers will help the audience make sustainable choices and communicate the sustainable initiatives to the audience.

Innovation

We are working on a mussel farm which can clean polluted sea water. We will also be showing "seabins", a new and innovative way of collecting trash in docks.


