From Holiday Activity to elite athlete

Severin Emil Bjerre is living proof that the Holiday Activities at Aarhus Tigers can lead to much more than a week of fun and new friends. The game got so deep under his skin that he joined the club and – after some years training – he qualified for the Danish National American Football Team.

In the summer of 2011, a cautious, little boy showed up for Holiday Activities at Aarhus Tigers. But before the first day of tackling, tossing and running was over, Severin Emil Bjerre felt right at home on the field in Viby.

American football was just the ticket. 'I signed up for one week of Holiday Activities at the Tigers, but I wound up doing the second week too. After that, I joined the club. American football was so exciting and different that it instantly swept me up,' Severing Emil Bjerre explains.

Since then, his trajectory just sky rocketed. He played on the Danish National Youth team and played elite American football for years. On the Danish National Team, he played the prestigi-

ous quarterback position. Today, Severin Emil Bjerre is 22 years old and works as a sergeant at the Danish Emergency Management Agency, and he coaches the Aarhus Tigers' senior team twice a week, not to mention that he is the head coach for the club's women's team.

'When I first started playing American football, I wasn't the fastest. I was a little overweight, which meant that I was never the best at playing football or swimming. But in American football, my weight wasn't an issue – actually, being on the large side was a plus. Because anyone can play on the team. Some have to run fast; others have to take hard tackles. Suddenly, the chubby boy in school was a star,' says Severin Emil Bjerre.

Which is why he encourages anyone eager to join the Aarhus Tigers' Holiday Activities to enrol.

'Age, size, gender and weight doesn't matter, there's room for everyone. You become part of a great community, which is what is so cool,'



Severin Emil Bjerre says and adds; 'If some parents or children are nervous that American football is too brutal, don't be. Obviously, it is different from regular football, where you chase the ball. Here, you chase the man. But it's a community that embraces little and big players alike, and we look out for each other and play for fun,' Severin Emil Bjerre explains.

Facts about Aarhus Tigers


With its 250 members, Aarhus Tigers is one of Denmark's biggest American football clubs.
